


- Small Israelite town belonging to the Tribe of Issachar, near the Jezreel Valley. Mount Carmel was about 20 miles west of Shunem.

Hebrews 13:2


 Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.

Character Trait #2 - FAITH Action Trust **Patience** When her son died, the Shunammite acted. She did not despair and she was not forlorn. She had faith that the man of God, Elisha could bring her son back to life. This was a well-established relationship over time. Deep trust developed between Elisha and the Shunammite's family. She had patience to wait for the outcome. How is this applicable for us today? Do we actively practise our faith? "Then Jesus declared, 'I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." John 6:35 "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:9 Do we trust in our God? Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6 Faith stories - recount them to each other!!! They edify and encourage!!



Character Trait #3 - RECOGNISE A HOLY MAN OF GOD Prophet (OT) - the calling on Elisha was to speak God's word, to be God's messenger. God's representative or ambassador by communicating God's word to his people. How did the Shunammite know Elisha was a prophet, one of God's messengers? Was she familiar with the prophets' words because she was an Israelite? Holiness - living a holy life, is it visible, why is this necessary? God calls his people to live holy lives so they can serve Him and one another: "But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light." 1Peter 2:9 Can we apply this today? Can we recognise holy men and women of God? "An unreliable messenger stumbles into trouble, but a reliable messenger brings healing." Proverbs 13:17
