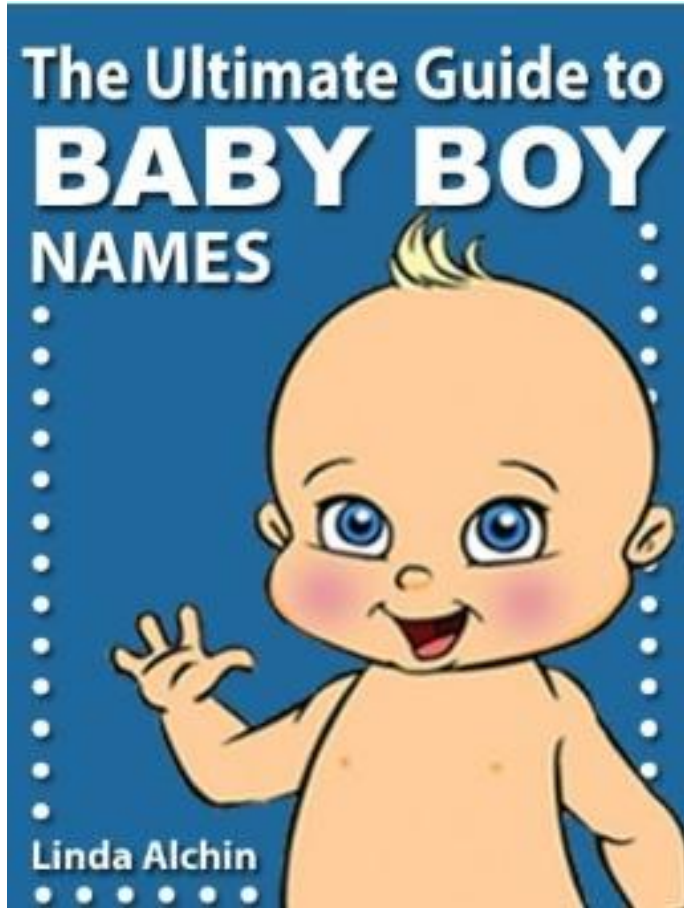

Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control

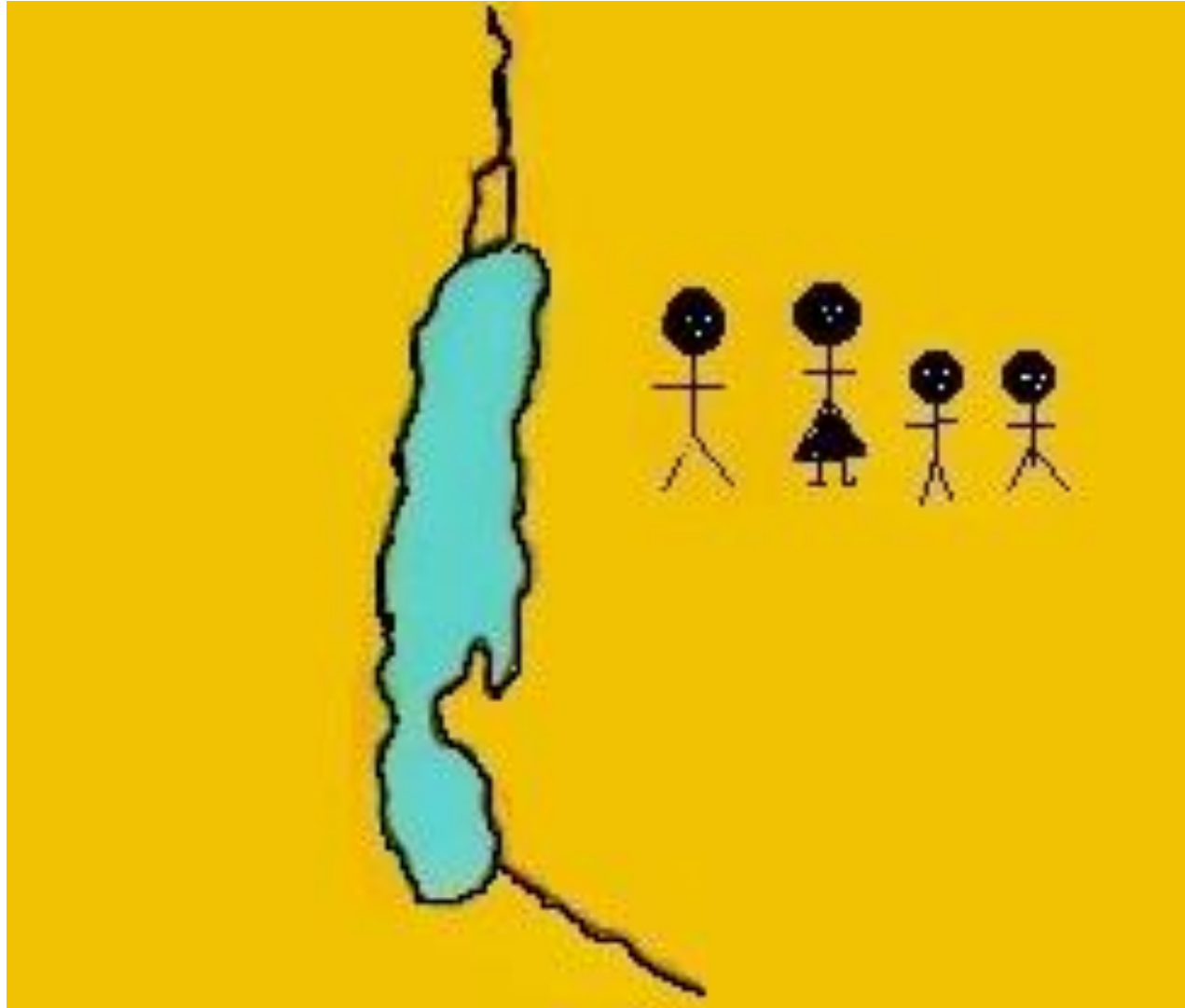

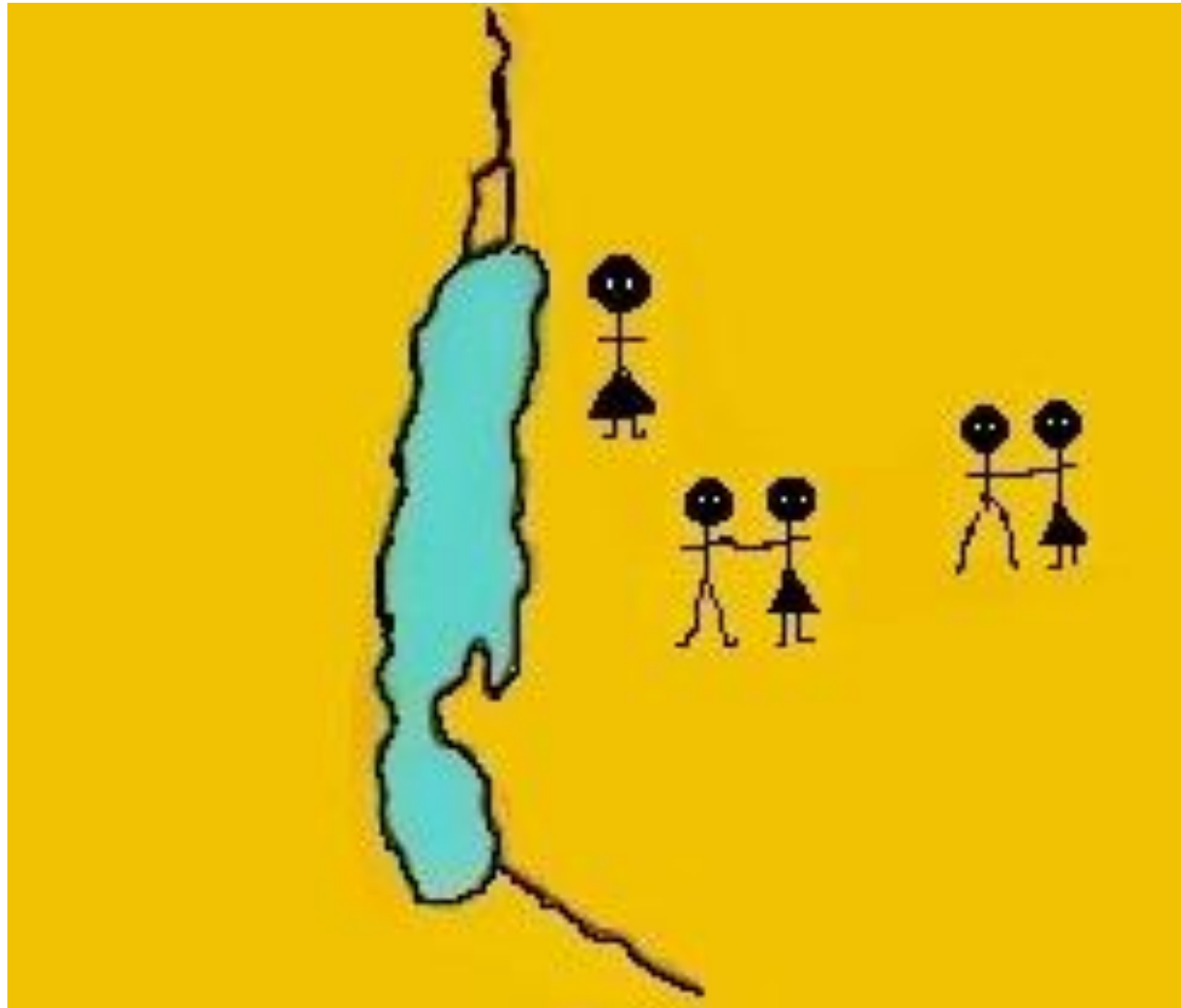




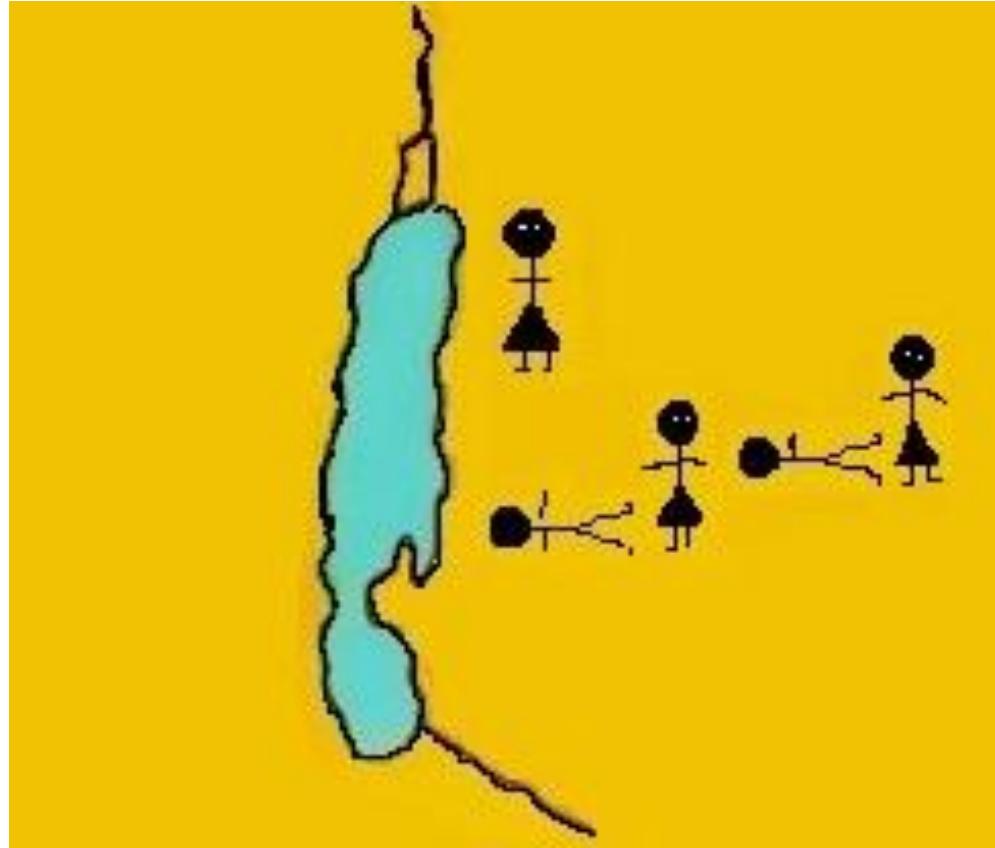
Elimelech dies...



The sons marry Moabite women....

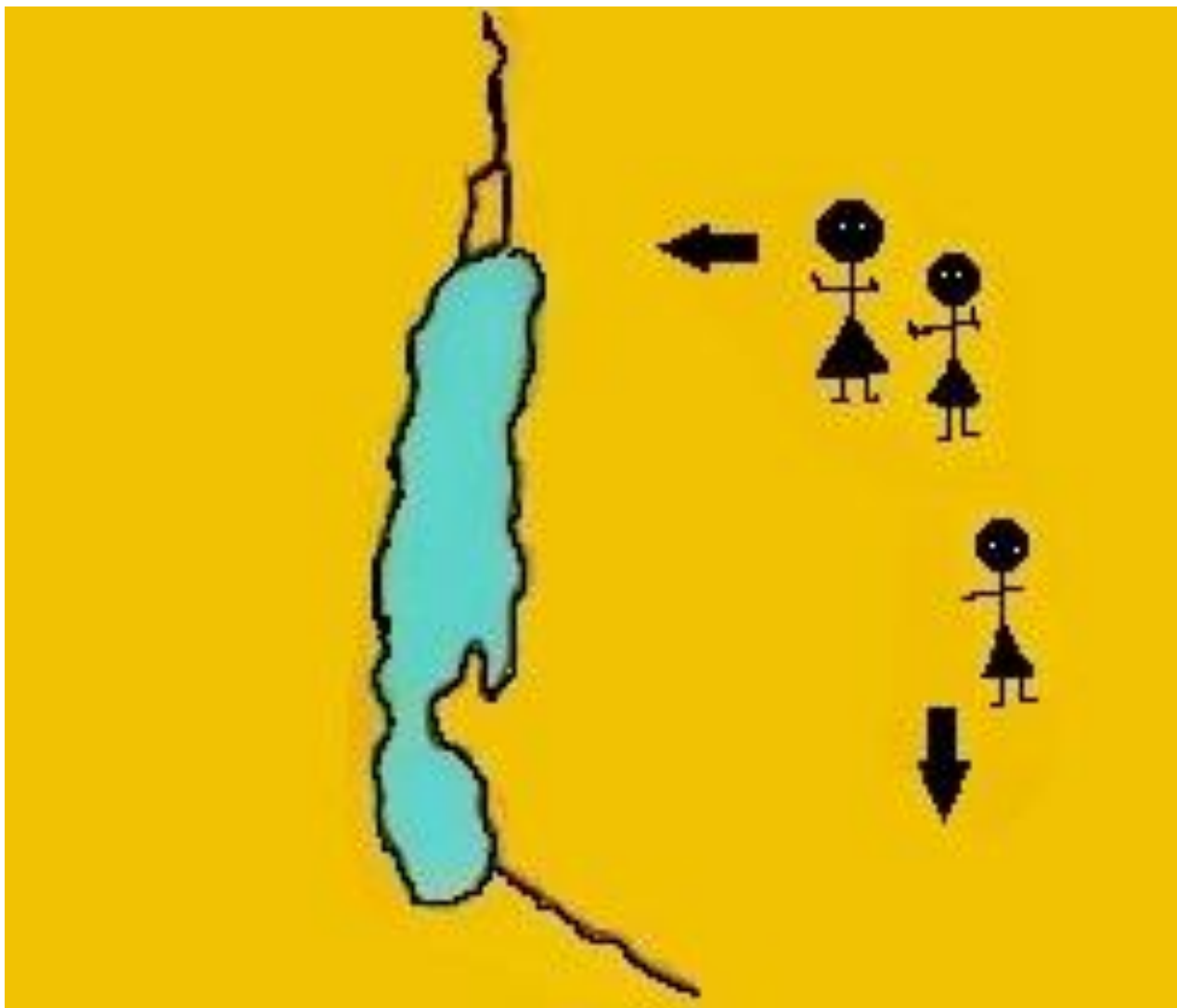

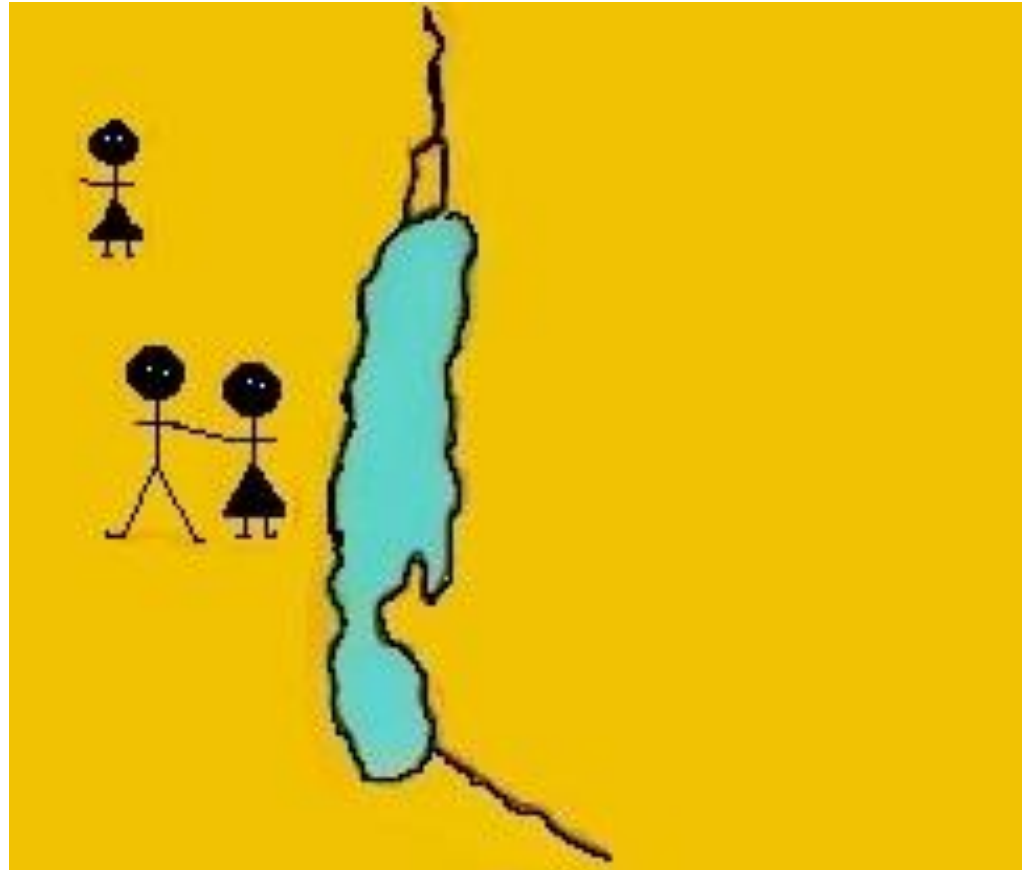




Naomi goes home, with Ruth...

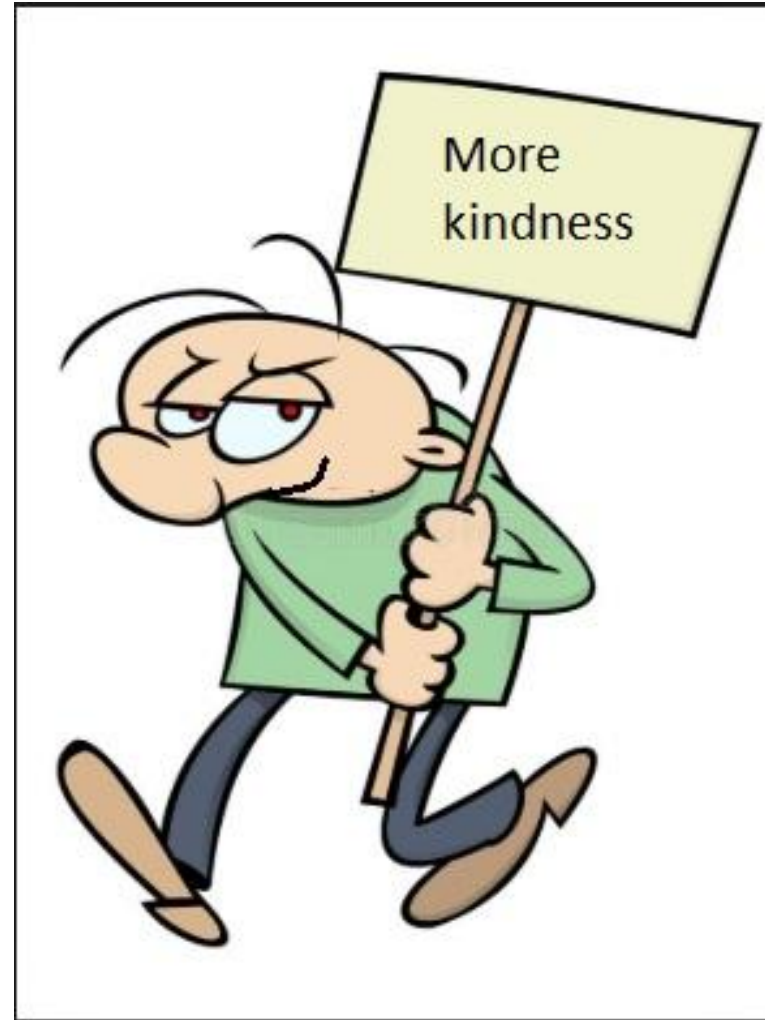
