SOUTH CENTRAL BIG CHURCH DAY OUT EVENT



How does the booking system work? We have a booking link for the Sphere with our prices set for the event.

Weekend: Adults £49, 5-16's £39, 1-4's £4. If you are camping the cost is Adults £20, 5-16's £10, 1-4's £4. For day visitors the costs are Adults £28, 5-16's £22, 1-4's £4.

When you book firstly you select how many adults, children (5-16) and under 4's. You also select for weekend or by the day. If you are camping, then on the next screen you'll see options to select for camping. Following that page, it will ask for your details and confirmation of purchase.

Does it take my money when I book if not when will it come out of my account? The payment comes out on the 21st May.

When can we arrive on site and what happens on Friday night? The site opens up at midday on the Friday 24th May. Once arriving on site come to the main camping gate where you will hopefully find a person from the Sphere to assist you to the campsite. In the marquee on the campsite there will be coffee/tea and cake to enjoy

Will the churches in the sphere be camping together? Yes, our churches will be on the same plot with a marquee that we have hired which will have a fridge, coffee/tea, tables, chairs. Last year there was plenty of space for everyone, we don't expect any trouble with amount of space for camping.

Will there be any electrical hook-ups for camping? No there are not any hook-ups, or driving of vehicles on the site, except for campers and caravans.

What about campers or caravans can they be used? Yes, you can bring campers/caravans, they are an additional one-off charge of £25 on top of the camping. They will be located next to the campsite or as close to the campsite as possible. Last year the marquee was next to the caravans.

Can I hire a caravan and have it delivered to the site? No you are not able to do this according to the Big Church Day Out procedures, the caravan must be brought on site by you not a hired company.

Will there be events for just our sphere? On the mornings of Saturday, Sunday and Monday we'll have the following gatherings

- 9am-10am – children up to age 10
- 10:30-11:30 – adults
- 10:30-11:30 – youth aged 11-18

We are planning on having a cooked breakfast together, along with lunch one day. It does not work as well to have a meal in the evening as so many are out at the concerts on the site.

When do the Big Church Day Out events happen? The stalls and stages start at 12:00 on the Saturday and Sunday. Throughout the day there are many activities for all ages, concerts, food stalls etc... In the evening there is a main stage worship gathering to finish the day.

How long can I stay on site? We have access to the site till Monday late afternoon, our programme finishes at 11:30am, the rest of the camping all has to be off site by noon.
